We will miss the BIG smile he carried around the office and to the sporting events. He always whistled while walking around the office while greeting everyone. He always greeted others with timeless saying like, “hold steady”, or “What’s up Doc?”. He was the kindest, genuine, and God loving person in the world. Mr. Oliver was born in 1940 and grew up in St Petersburg, Florida playing baseball every day. He was drafted by Los Angeles Dodgers in 1959.
