



Winfrey Ford

May 2, 1913 - June 16, 2015

Winfrey Ford died peacefully in her sleep in her home in San Francisco on June 16, 2015 at the age of 102. She was born in Upland, Arkansas on May 2, 1913 to John and Martha Broadnex. During her early years, she was a nursery school teacher. In 1945, she and her four children (Algin Ford, Margaret Ford (Lewis), John Ford, and Alyce Ford (Gilbert)) relocated from Texas to California.

Winfrey was one of the founding members of Evergreen Baptist Church. Later, her sisters Elsie Geter and Mary Simmons became members of Evergreen Baptist Church. During her years in San Francisco, she worked at the Naval Shipyard and later completed 40 years as a healthcare giver before her retirement.

Winfrey Ford departed this life on Tuesday, June 16, 2015. She leaves to mourn her death and to cherish her memories; her daughter Alyce Ford-Gilbert, her son John Ford, her sister Marjorie Sanders of El Dorado, Arkansas, grandchildren and other relatives.
